LUXURY SELF CATERING – from £507



CHALET HEIDI **ZERMATT, SWITZERLAND**

With its views of the mighty Matterhorn, Zermatt is one of the few resorts where long-suffering non-skiing or snowboarding partners can enjoy themselves while their mates are hammering down the mountain. The ski area is linked to that of Cervinia in Italy giving a total of 350km of pistes served by 59 lifts. The newly refurbished Chalet Heidi, near the church, is the perfect blend of traditional wood and high-tech contemporary. It sleeps six. From £507, not including travel, with Mountain Exposure.

MOUNTAIN HAUS **VAIL, USA**

One of the world's most lavish resorts, Vail has a seemingly unlimited budget for constantly improving. The slopes on the front face, above the resort, are as sleek and immaculately groomed as its visitors, while on the other side of the mountain, the Back Bowls and Blue Sky Basin appeal to powderhounds. Ski Safari offers holidays to the four-star Mountain Haus in Vail Village, which has a choice of richly-furnished condos. Guests have access to an outdoor pool, hot tubs, a sauna, steam room and gym.
